

Opening for a Research Assistant

The Research Assistant would be working on a project to collect, clean and analyze data on refugees and asylum seekers in the Italian reception system. The tasks performed by the Research Assistant may include contacting Italian administrative offices, building datasets from the data received, implementing preliminary data analysis.

The ideal candidate should have an undergraduate degree (or more) in Economics. Individuals with other educational backgrounds are also welcome to apply. Candidates should be comfortable interacting with Italian bureaucracy, advanced at STATA, R or Python, and proficient at Microsoft Excel.

Employment can begin immediately and part-time employment can be guaranteed for 1 month, with a possible extension for 1 additional month. The Research Assistant must be able to commit at least 20 hours per week over at least 2 months. The exact arrangement of hours worked is flexible, as is the location of the work.

The pay is fixed at 900 euros per month (before taxes).
